Building owners, managers, operators, energy auditors, and anyone interested in San Francisco's energy goals and programs.

What is the purpose of the Ordinance?

The ordinance requires all commercial buildings larger than 10,000 square feet to track energy use with ENERGY STAR® Portfolio Manager, publicly share a brief annual summary of energy performance, and undergo an energy audit every five years. These three actions provide a benchmark to compare over time and with others, the motivation of transparency, and clear options for cost-effective improvements.
